Programs Offered	LL.B.(Hons.), LL.M. (1 year).
Program Duration	The duration of LL.B.(Hons.) program is 4 years and for LL.M., 1 year.
Total Credits	LL.B.(Hons.): 147 Credits LL.M.: 41 Credits
Admission Test	Prospective students must sit for written admission test.

Brief Overview of LL.B. (Hons.) Program

LL.B.(Hons.) is a 4-year program consisting of 8 consecutive semesters. Students are to complete 147 credits including a Legal Research Methodology of 3 credits and a Dissertation for another 3 credits. In addition to these there remains a viva voce examination of 3 credits. The students have to appear at a viva voce examination at the end of each academic year (after every 2 consecutive semesters).

Admission requirements for LL.B. (Hons.) Program

- i. Minimum CGPA of 8.00 (combined) is required by considering SSC and HSC examinations.
- ii. Maximum of 02(two) years of academic break may be considered for admission purposes.
- iii. Students must have at least a —B|| grade in English at SSC and HSC levels.
- iv. Those who have academic discontinuity of not more than 2 years for any unavoidable ground, in that case, may apply before the vice chancellor for getting permission for admission.
- v. Those who have a CGPA of 7 (combined) considering SSC and HSC examinations or have a C grade in English, have to qualify for the Admission Test to be arranged by the Department of Law and Justice.
- vi. The department will arrange the admission test focusing on the English language,

grammar, and general knowledge.

vii. UGC and BUBT guidelines will be followed for other issues relating to admission purposes.

viii. The above-mentioned rules may be flexible for students with physical disabilities.

Department of Law and Justice will encourage any student coming from a minority group, tribal, or child of a freedom fighter, etc.

ix. Candidates must have passed University of London and Cambridge GCE O Level in at least five subjects and A Level in at least two subjects. Only the best five subjects in O level and best two subjects in A level will be considered. Out of these seven subjects, a candidate must have at least 4 —B grade or GPA of 4.00 in the four subjects and 3 —C grades or GPA of 3.5 in the remaining three subjects, (in the scale of A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, and E=1).

To serve the physically challenged, disabled and autistic people:

The University welcomes applications from disabled applicants and the University aims to make all of the services it provides as accessible as possible. This includes disability, physical challenge, autism or any other incapacity of similar kind. The University is therefore committed to a program of action to make the policy fully effective for every sect of population. For the admission of students with any of the aforesaid disabilities, an admission test will be arranged in the mildest form by the department considering their incapacity in mind.

Admission Procedure for LL.B. (Hons.) Program:

Admission form and prospectus are available in the admission office/ reception desk. After verification of the necessary documents, the applicants are allowed to deposit the admission fees and sign on the application form to complete the admission process.

The following documents are needed at the time of admission:

- Two passport size color photographs (studio lab print with white background for ID card purpose).
- Photocopies of (one copy each):

- i. Certificates and mark sheets/transcripts of SSC/O-Level, HSC/A-Level /Diploma, Bachelor degree or other equivalent examinations.
- ii. Registration card of SSC/O-Level/other equivalent examinations for undergraduate programs.
- iii. Birth certificate/ National ID card of the candidate (one copy each).

Brief Overview of LL.M. (One Year) program

At BUBT, LL. M. is a 1 Year program consisting of 2 consecutive semesters. Students who have successfully completed LL.B. (Hons) degree from any recognized University may be admitted in the program. They have to complete 12 courses and a total 41 credits under the program. The program is designed to prepare the students for careers in law to become good lawyers, judges, academics and professionals in multifarious dimensions of law.

Admission requirements for LL.M. program:

- i. Minimum CGPA of 2.5 in LL.B. (Hon's) is required for admission to the LLM program.
- ii. Graduation must be completed from any UGC-approved university.
- iii. Students must submit their equivalent certificate from the proper authorities, who have acquired 3 years of Bachelor of Laws I.e. British LLB (Hons.) Degree.
- iv. The above-mentioned rules may be flexible for students with physical disabilities. Department of Law and Justice will encourage any student coming from a minority group, tribal, or child of a freedom fighter, etc.

Admission form and prospectus are available in the admission office/ reception desk. After verification of the necessary documents, the applicants are allowed to deposit the admission fees and sign on the application form to complete the admission process.

Photocopies of SSC/O-Level, HSC/A-Level, Bachelor degree or equivalent examinations certificates and mark sheets/transcripts and birth certificate/ national ID card (one copy each).

Original certificate, mark sheets/transcripts and birth certificate /national ID card must be produced for verification by the officer of BUBT in charge of admission.

The Application Form along with Prospectus may also be obtained by ordinary post from the Registrar's Office by sending a Bank draft or Pay order of 500 BDT in favour of Bangladesh University of Business and Technology (BUBT) and a duly stamped self-addressed envelope.
