

In recognition of the growing importance of global education and the need to foster cross-cultural academic exchange, the Department of Law and Justice at Bangladesh University of Business and Technology (BUBT) is committed to promoting inclusivity and diversity within its academic community.

Eligibility Criteria

Undergraduate Program (LL.B. Honours)

- Must have completed at least 12 years of formal education equivalent to Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) or A-Levels, Edexcel, etc.
- Must provide certified academic transcripts and certificates translated into English (if not originally in English).
- Must meet minimum GPA or equivalent standards as set by the department/university.
- Equivalence certificate in case of foreign degrees or educational qualifications.

Postgraduate Program (LL.M.)

- Must have completed a 4-year undergraduate degree in Law or equivalent (LL.B. Honours) from a recognised university.
- Academic credentials must be evaluated for equivalency with BUBT standards.

Language Proficiency

All international applicants must demonstrate proficiency in English through one of the following:

- IELTS (minimum score 6.0); TOEFL (minimum score 78 iBT); LSAT 152; or GMAT 546.
- Proof of prior academic instruction in English (if required)
- Departmental interview or written assessment (if required)

Application Procedure

- Complete and submit the **International Student Admission Form** (available on the university/department website).
- Submit a Statement of Purpose (SOP) within 2000 words.
- Submit two Letters of Recommendation (LORs).
- Attach scanned copies of:
 - Passport (with at least 6 months' validity)
 - Academic certificates and transcripts

- Proof of English proficiency
 - Passport-size photographs
 - Other valid documents as per the policy of BUBT
- Pay the non-refundable application processing fee as determined by BUBT.
- Attend online/offline interviews (if required).
- Await the issuance of the Offer Letter upon successful evaluation.
- Apply for a student visa with the Offer Letter and complete immigration formalities.

Admission Quota

- Five percent of total seats may be reserved for international applicants, subject to availability and academic merit.
- Final seat allocation is subject to approval by the university authority.

Fees and Financial Information

- International students will pay tuition and other fees at rates specified for foreign nationals.
- All fees must be paid in USD or its equivalent as per BUBT's financial guidelines.
- Fee waivers, scholarships, or special considerations (if any) will be decided on a case-by-case basis.

Visa and Immigration Compliance

- International students must abide by the visa regulations of the Government of Bangladesh.
- The university will assist in issuing visa support documents, but it is not responsible for visa denials.
- Students must maintain full-time enrollment status as per visa conditions.
